

Portable HF Whip Antenna P/N: CHA MIL 2.0

26-54 MHz

The CHA MIL 2.0 is a broadband collapsible monopole antenna designed for portable or manpack radios requiring a compact but rugged antenna system.

If used by itself, the antenna will cover 26-54 MHz with an external antenna tuner. When installed with the CHA HYBRI MICRO or MINI, it becomes a broadband HF antenna covering 1.8-54 MHz* when used with an external antenna tuner.

* Limited performance below 3.5 MHz.

A ground-plane or counterpoise is required for optimal performance.

Operator's Note:

When collapsing the CHA MIL 2.0, begin with the top section to extend the life of the internal braided cord.

The design of the CHA MIL 2.0 has been borrowed from similar antennas utilized by armies all over the world. The CHA MIL WHIP 2.0 is very sturdy and portable. When collapsed, the entire antenna length is a mere 17". The seven brass sections are held together by a spring-loaded braided cord.

This is an excellent add-on for the CHA HYBRID MICRO or MINI and is included in the very popular CHA MPAS 2.0.

The package consists of:

1 X CHA MIL 2.0 made of seven 17" sections made of tapered brass.
